permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada,

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source, particularly for the meadows below the land herein described. A standard headgate and weir must be installed at or near the point of diversion to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any time. The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed Six & 4/10 cubic feet per second. (6.4)

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 5, 1916.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before July 5, 1916.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before September 5, 1916.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before December 5, 1922. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before January 5, 1923.
