permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada,

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Amargosa River

2. The amount of water applied for is Two and one half second-feet.
One second-foot equals 40 miners' inches.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source.

The applicant must install at or near the point of diversion a standard headgate and weir to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed Eight tenths cubic feet per second. (0.8)

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 2, 1915.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before October 2, 1915.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before September 2, 1917.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 2, 1918. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before November 2, 1918.
