This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed One tenth cubic feet per second. (0.1)

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 8, 1916.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 8, 1916.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 8, 1916.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before May 8, 1918.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before June 8, 1918.
