permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada,  
as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation give date and  
place of incorporation.) January 27th 1913 under laws of Nevada.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Snow and Flood

2. The amount of water applied for is 29.6 second-feet.  
One second-foot equals 40 miners' inches.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

A dam will be constructed at point of diversion and then via State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water ditch constructed by us to bring the water filed on under Permits is to be stored in reservoirs it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions. #3308-3309-3310-3311 to our land (same ditch for both waters)

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source, the water right acquired hereunder being appurtenant only to the following described lands:

E 1/2 NE 1/4 and E 1/2 SE 1/4 Sec. 19; NW 1/4, SE 1/4, W 1/2 NE 1/4, W 1/2 SW 1/4 and NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 20; SW 1/4, S 1/2 SE 1/4 and NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 21; N 1/2 NW 1/4 Sec. 27; NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 29; E 1/2 SE 1/4 Sec. 36, T. 36 N.R. 19 E., M.D.B & M., and Lots 3 and 4 of Sec. 31, T. 36 N.R. 20 E., M.D.B & M.

The amount of water herein granted is placed at 12.4 cubic feet per second for the full acreage above described, notwithstanding the fact that a partial storage right has been granted for this land under permits Nos. 3308 to 3311 inclusive, so that such amount of water may be diverted and used when available, thereby reserving the waters stored under and by virtue of said permits Nos. 3308 to 3311 inclusive for use during the period of late irrigation and shortage of water supply. The total amount of water granted from all sources combined, however, must not exceed the statutory allowance for the total acreage described. A standard headgate and weir must be installed at or near the point of diversion to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before September 16, 1923. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before October 16, 1923.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before September 16, 1919.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before September 16, 1925.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before October 16, 1923.
