APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source and in conjunction with permits Nos. 3415, 3416, and 3652, a portion of the same land being described in all four filings. The amount of water herein granted is placed at 1.13 cubic feet per second so that such amount of water may be diverted and used in the event that there is a shortage in any of the sources described in permits Nos. 3415, 3416 and 3652. The applicant will be required at the time of filing proof of beneficial use of water to definitely segregate the areas of land which obtain water for irrigation purposes from each source described in these four permits. A standard headgate and weir must be installed at or near the point of diversion to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of water herein granted at any time.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.13 cubic feet per second. (One and thirteen one-hundredths)

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 10, 1916.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before July 10, 1916.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 10, 1917.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before June 10, 1921.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before July 10, 1921.
