APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

Date of first receipt and filing in State Engineer's office JUN 30 1915

The undersigned, L.C. Denton and R.F. Shinn, of Caliente, County of Lincoln, State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation give date and place of incorporation.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Cottonwood Spring, Name of stream, lake, or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 1/5 second-feet. One second-foot equals 40 miners' inches.

3. The water to be used for Stock and Domestic Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.

4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: N. 31° 15' E., 14420 feet from the NE corner of the Emma Patented Mine in the Delamar Mining District. Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, or by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land it should be so stated

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

(a) Number of acres to be irrigated is

(e) Works to be located S. 32° 10' E., 13800 feet from the NE corner of the Emma Patented Mine in the Delamar Mining District. Give 40-acre subdivision on which works will be located, or locate by course and distance to a section corner.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source and on condition that if the spring herein applied for proves later to be identical with the Cottonwood Spring on which the protestant holds an alleged vested right, this permit will automatically become void. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. It is distinctly understood that applicant agrees to the terms herein contained.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed One-fortieth cubic foot per second. (0.025)

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 6, 1917.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before August 6, 1917.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 6, 1919.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before December 6, 1919. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before January 6, 1920.
