DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

The water will be diverted by means of a dam placed in the State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water is to be stored in reservoirs it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions. Carson River, and the water conveyed to the lands to be irrigated by means of enlargements of old ditches. New lateral ditches will be added wherever necessary to place the land under proper cultivation.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source and is for flood and unappropriated water only. It is expressly understood and made a condition of this permit that diversion of water by the applicant shall cease immediately upon notification from the State Engineer that a shortage of water exists in the source herein described. A standard headgate and weir must be installed at or near the point of diversion to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. It is distinctly understood that applicant agrees to the terms herein contained. The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed Four (4.0) cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 12, 1917.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before August 12, 1917.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 12, 1919.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 12, 1923. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before November 12, 1923.
