2. The amount of water applied for is 4/10 cubic feet per second-foot.
3. The water to be used for Irrigation
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following
point: in the SW corner of the SW 1/4 NW 1/4, section 17, T. 24 N., R. 20 E.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source.

A standard headgate and weir must be installed at or near the point of diversion to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed Four tenths cubic feet per second. (0.4)

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 2, 1916.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 2, 1916.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 2, 1916.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before May 2, 1918.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before June 2, 1918.
