APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

Date of first receipt and filing in State Engineer's office AUG 4, 1915

The undersigned F. Thos. Hunter, Name of applicant, of Lee, County of Elko, State of Nevada, hereby make\_s application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation give date and place of incorporation.)

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Rattle Snake Creek, a tributary of the South Fork of the Humboldt River.
2. The amount of water applied for is Four (4) second-feet.
3. The water to be used for Irrigation
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: SW 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec. 32, T. 31 N.R. 57 E., M.D.M.

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (a) Number of acres to be irrigated is 160
(b) Description of land to be irrigated NW 1/4 of Sec. 27, T. 31 N.R. 56 E., M.D.M.
(c) Irrigation will begin about May 15th and end about July 15th, of each year.

IF WATER IS TO BE USED FOR POWER, MINING, TRANSPORTATION, OR OTHER USE, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (d) Power to be developed is horse power.
(e) Works to be located
(f) Point of return of water to stream Water not to be returned.
(g) Remarks I am applying only for unappropriated and surplus water. I have talked with all of the owners of ditches from Rattle Snake Creek, and they are all willing that I should be granted a permit for this water so far as they are concerned.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Dam to be constructed of earth, rocks, willows and brush, to be State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water about Ten (10) feet long and between Three (3) and Four (4) feet high. is to be stored in reservoirs it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions.

This dam at the point of diversion will divert the water from Rattle Snake Creek and by means of open cuts and ditches, the water will be conveyed a distance of about five or six miles to and upon the land to be irrigated, and there by means of laterals will be distributed over the land.

- 5. Estimated cost of works about Five Hundred or Six Hundred Dollars.
6. Estimated time required to construct works Three months if permitted to carry on work before ground freezes in 1915 and as soon as the

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the stream system of which this source is tributary and is for flood and surplus water only. A standard headgate and weir must be installed at or near the point of diversion to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any time. The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed One & 6/10 cubic feet per second. (1.6)

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 27, 1916.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 27, 1916.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before August 27, 1916.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before November 27, 1920. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before December 27, 1920.
