

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

An open cut 100 feet long, 4 feet wide to a 16-foot face, 4 feet wide; a tunnel 10 feet long, 4 feet wide and 5 1/2 feet high, water to be diverted through one-inch pipe 190 feet to a trough 31 inches wide, 16 inches deep and 62 feet long.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 3, 1916.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before September 3, 1916.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 3, 1916.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before August 3, 1918. Proof of the application of water to beneficial

use must be filed with State Engineer on or before September 3, 1918.

The undersigned James B. Wilson and Tweed A. Wilson
of Las Vegas, County of Clark, State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation give date and place of incorporation.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is McClanahan Spring.
Name of stream, lake, or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 100 gallons per hour.
One second-foot equals 40 miners' inches.

3. The water to be used for domestic and stock-watering purposes
