APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source. The amount of water herein granted is placed at 0.8 of a cubic foot per second for the full acreage of land described, notwithstanding the fact that the same land has already been granted a water right from Mining Canon under permit No. 2401, so that such amount of water may be diverted and used in the event there is no water available from the said Mining Canon. However, the total amount of water granted from the combined sources described in these two permits shall not exceed the statutory allowance for the maximum acreage of land to be irrigated thereunder. The applicant will be required at the time of filing proof of beneficial use of water to definitely segregate the areas of land which obtain water for irrigation purposes from this source and the land which is irrigated from Mining Canon under permit No. 2401. A standard headgate and weir must be installed at or near the point of diversion to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before May 1, 1917.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before December 1, 1919. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before January 1, 1920.
