

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The undersigned H.E. Robinson & W.E. Cordell
of Jarbridge, County of Elko, State of Nevada, hereby makes application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation give date and place of incorporation.)

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Deer Creek,
2. The amount of water applied for is 3.2 second-feet.
3. The water to be used for Irrigation & domestic.
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: On unsurveyed land to Govt. Mon. 7 U.S.L.M. #230 bears S. 30° E., 6000' & to south pole of wireless Sta N. 77° E. 1354'.

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (a) Number of acres to be irrigated is 320
(b) Description of land to be irrigated Unsurveyed but will probably be in Sections 29 & 30 T. 47 N.R. 58 E., M.D.B & M.
(c) Irrigation will begin about Apr. 15 and end about Sept. 15 of each year.

IF WATER IS TO BE USED FOR POWER, MINING, TRANSPORTATION, OR OTHER USE, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (d) Power to be developed is horse power.
(e) Works to be located
(f) Point of return of water to stream Not returned.

(g) Remarks The pt of this application conforms identically with application #3401. The pt of diversion is the only feasible one & it is the intentions of all parties concerned to construct ditch together & use it together. Mr. Miller advises us that there is ample water for 640 acres of land

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Water to be diverted by dam & put on land by ditch.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the stream system of which this source is a tributary. A standard headgate and weir must be installed at or near the point of diversion to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed Three & 2/10 cubic feet per second. (3.2)

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 27, 1916.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 27, 1916.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before May 27, 1918.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before May 27, 1922.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before June 27, 1922.
