The undersigned, Sheba Gold & Silver Mining Company, of Imlay, County of Humboldt, State of Nevada, hereby makes application to change the point of diversion of the water of Star Canon, Humboldt County, Nevada, heretofore appropriated and beneficially used by them as hereinafter shown.

- 1. The source of the water supply of the proposed change is melted snow, springs and running water of the Star Canon basin.
2. The quantity of water desired to be changed is 15 cubic feet per second.
3. The water to be used for mining, milling and for the domestic purposes necessary thereto.
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: At a point in the stream bed in the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 22, Township 31 North, Range 34 East.
5. The existing point of diversion under the former appropriation is as follows: At a point about 600 feet East from the present applied for point of diversion, and in the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 22, Township 31 North, Range 34 East.
6. The water herewith desired to be changed, has been beneficially and continuously used upon patented mill-site of United States Lot #37.
7. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$5000.
8. The estimated date required to complete the work is March 1, 1916.
9. The water has been used heretofore during the months from Jan. 1st to Dec. 31st of each year.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the point of diversion of the waters of Star Canon Creek, as claimed in proof of appropriation No. 01446, is issued for the amount of water claimed in such proof, namely ten second feet. If, upon determination of the alleged vested right, it is proven that the applicant is not entitled to such amount of water, then in that event, the amount of water granted hereunder will be accordingly reduced to conform with the amount set forth in such determination. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water under the proposed change at any and all times. It is distinctly understood that applicant agrees to the terms herein contained.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed ten (10) cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 26, 1917.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before July 26, 1917.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before September 26, 1917.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before June 26, 1919. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before July 26, 1919.
