Water to be impounded by means of a dam to be constructed in bed of Slaughterhouse creek at above point of diversion; the dam having a width of 115 feet at the base and width of about 10 feet at the crest, with an approximate length at the crest of 209 feet; the foregoing specifications being subject to change to conform to design of structure; said dam forming a reservoir of approximately 300 acre-feet capacity.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source. The State reserves the right to regulate the diversion and storage of water herein granted at any and all times. Work must be prosecuted continuously and uninterruptedly to completion as provided by Section 65, Chapter 140, Statutes of Nevada, 1913.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 300 acre cubic feet per second. annum for storage.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 6, 1917.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before July 6, 1917.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 6, 1920.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before June 6, 1922.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before July 6, 1922.

Applicant proposes to store water in reservoir, using same to equalize the flow in the proposed pipe-line, in addition to obtaining by said dam and reservoir, a supply of additional water.

On account of continuous draw-off from reservoir by proposed pipe-line, when completed and in operation, the above 300 acre-foot capacity does not represent the total annual supply desired, but it is desired to use the full flow of the stream, thus keeping the reservoir filled continuously.

This application is made subordinate to, and to supplement, the Crowell Ranch vested right to said waters, as said vested right was modified by Permit No. 536, granted by the State Engineer to the Round Mountain Hydraulic Mining Company, a corporation, on November 9, 1907, and by said corporation transferred to the Round Mountain Power and Water Company, a corporation, and transferred by said last-named company to applicant by deed and assignment dated February 29, 1916, recorded March 27, 1916, in the office of the Recorder of Nye County; a certified copy of which deed and assignment is on file in the office of the State Engineer. The water hereby applied for is to be united with the waters embraced in said Crowell Ranch vested right as modified by said Permit No. 536 and is to be used for the same purposes and on the same lands.
