This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source and particularly subject to the right acquired by the Adams-McGill Company as set forth in Certificate No. 71, Book 2, issued under proof of appropriation No. 0795. It is specifically understood that the point of diversion herein described will be located below the diversion of the Adams-McGill Company as described in the above mentioned certificate. A standard headgate and weir must be installed at or near the point of diversion to facilitate the measurement and control of the water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. It is distinctly understood that applicant agrees to the terms herein contained.

0.25 cubic feet per second. (One-fourth)

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 13th, 1917.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before September 13th, 1917

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 13th, 1917.

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before November 13th, 1917. Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before

August 13th, 1918 Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before September 13th, 1918
