permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada,
as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation give date and

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Grape Vine Spring
2. The amount of water applied for is one second-feet.
3. The water to be used for Irrigation
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following
point: NW 1/4 of SE 1/4 Sec. 29, Tp. 21 South, Range 62 East Mt. Diablo
Base & Meridian.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source. It is distinctly understood and made a condition of this permit that the channel adjacent to the springs applied for be left open so as not to interfere with the watering of stock. It is also distinctly understood that applicant must provide some manner of conduit, either cement lined or puddled ditch or pipeline that will prevent an excessive loss of water in said conduit. A standard headgate and weir must be installed at or near the point of diversion to facilitate the measurement and control of the water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. It is distinctly understood that applicant agrees to the terms herein contained.

- Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 6th, 1917.
- Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before November 6th, 1917.
- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 6th, 1919.
- Proof of completion of work shall be filed before November 6th, 1919.
- Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 6th, 1921
- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before November 6th, 1921.
