APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the stream system of which this source is a tributary. It is specifically understood that diversion of water under this permit is not to interfere with older rights on the stream system. A standard headgate and weir must be installed at or near the point of diversion to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. It is distinctly understood that applicant agrees to the terms herein contained.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed Two & 3/10 cubic feet per second. (2.3)

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 28, 1917.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before July 28, 1917.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 28, 1919.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before September 28, 1922. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before October 28, 1922.
