APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source, and on the condition that the watering trough now in existence at the springs shall be maintained and shall at all times remain filled so that water will always be available for stock ranging in this vicinity, as well as the traveling public. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. It is distinctly understood that applicant agrees to the terms herein contained.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed One half cubic feet per second. (0.5)

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 16, 1917.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before July 16, 1917.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before December 16, 1917.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before June 16, 1919. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before July 16, 1919.
