The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed One fiftieth cubic feet per second. (0.02)

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 19, 1917.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before July 19, 1917.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 19, 1918.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before June 19, 1919.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before July 19, 1919.
