DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Water is diverted by dam, through ditch 3 ft. wide by State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water is to be stored in reservoirs it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions. 1 foot deep, with fall of 1/4 inch. to the rod.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the stream system of which this source is a tributary. A standard headgate and weir must be installed at or near the point of diversion to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. It is distinctly understood that applicant agrees to the terms herein contained.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed One & 1/2 cubic feet per second. -- (1.5)

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 22, 1917.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before October 22, 1917.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before September 22, 1917.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before May 22, 1922. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before June 22, 1922.
