located on SE 1/4 NE. 1/4 Sec. 3 T 18 S. R. 50 E. M. D. B & M.
2. The amount of water applied for is One & 60/100 second-feet.
3. The water to be used for Irrigation.
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following
point: North line SE. 1/4 SE. 1/4 Sec. 4 T. 18 S. R. 50 E. M. D. B & M.

- (a) Number of acres to be irrigated is 160 acres.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source.

A standard headgate and weir must be installed at or near the point of diversion to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. It is distinctly understood that applicant agrees to the terms herein contained. The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.6 cubic feet per second. (One and six-tenths)

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 29th, 1917

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before September 29th, 1917.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before February 29th, 1918.

Proof of Completion of Work shall be filed before March 29th, 1918.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before

August 29th, 1921 Proof of the application of water to beneficial

use must be filed with State Engineer on or before September 29th, 1921.

Proof of completion of work filed MAR 25 1918 of June, 1917
