This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source, and on condition that the applicants shall construct and maintain at or near the spring, suitable troughs, which troughs shall at all times remain filled, so that water will always be available for stock ranging in this vicinity, as well as for the traveling public. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. It is distinctly understood that applicants agree to the terms herein contained.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.0 cubic foot per second. (One)

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 22d, 1918.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 22d, 1918.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before May 22d, 1921.

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before June 22d, 1921.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before May 22d, 1922.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before June 22d, 1922.
