State of NEVADA, hereby makes application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation give date and place of incorporation.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Dry Valley Creek,  
Name of stream, lake, or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 960 acre ft. or 2.4 second-feet.  
One second-foot equals 40 miners' inches.

3. The water to be used for Irrigation and domestic purposes.  
Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.

4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: In the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec. 5, T. 24 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M.,  
Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, or by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

(c) Irrigation will begin about April 1st and end about October 31st,

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Water will be diverted by means of small earth and rock dam into a ditch which will convey the waters to a reservoir where it will be stored, and then conveyed to the lands to be irrigated by means of ditches and laterals.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source and is for the storage of water during the non-irrigation season from November 1st of each year to April 1st of the following year. A standard headgate and weir must be installed at or near the point of diversion to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. It is distinctly understood that applicant agrees to the terms herein contained.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 960 acre cubic feet per second annum. (Nine Hundred and Sixty)

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 19th, 1918.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before July 19th, 1918.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 19th, 1921.

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before July 19th, 1921.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before

June 19th, 1925. Proof of the application of water to beneficial

use must be filed with State Engineer on or before July 19th, 1925.
