State of Nevada, hereby make s application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation give date and place of incorporation.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Crystal Spring Name of stream, lake, or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 2/10 second-feet. One second-foot equals 40 miners' inches.

3. The water to be used for Irrigation and Stock purposes Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.

4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: Near the S.W. Corner of the S.E. 1/4 of the N.E. 1/4 of Sec 22 Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, or by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land it should be so stated T. 2 N.R. 50 E. M.D.M.

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (a) Number of acres to be irrigated is 40
(b) Description of land to be irrigated S.E. 1/4 of N.E. 1/4 of Sec 22, Describe by legal subdivision, or if on unsurveyed land it T. 2 N.R. 50 E. M.D.M.

should be so stated and a description provided in accordance with special instruction from the State Engineer when application is returned for correction.

(c) Irrigation will begin about April 15 and end about Nov 1 Month, of each year.

IF WATER IS TO BE USED FOR POWER, MINING, TRANSPORTATION, OR OTHER USE, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (d) Power to be developed is horse power.
(e) Works to be located Give 40-acre subdivision on which works will be located, or locate by course and distance to a section corner.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Water being developed and conserved from small springs and piped to land irrigated.

The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. It is distinctly understood that the applicant agrees to the terms herein contained.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.2 cubic feet per second. (two tenths)

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 22, 1918.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before July 22, 1918.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 22, 1919.

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before July 22, 1919.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before June 22, 1920. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before July 22, 1920.
