

- The amount of water applied for is 10.40 second-feet.  
from April 15 to June 15 and 2100 Acre-feet from June 15 to October 1st.
- The water to be used for Irrigation and domestic purposes  
Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.
- The water is to be diverted from its source at the following  
point: in S.W. 1/4 of N.E. 1/4 of Sec. 25, T. 43 N.R. 50 E., M.D.M.  
Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, or by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

It is proposed to construct an earth fill dam 40 feet in Height which will form a reservoir having a surface area of approximately 150 acres and a capacity of about 2100 Acre-feet. From this dam the water will be conveyed to the land to be irrigated by means of ditches partly to be constructed and partly already constructed under Permits Nos. 1768 and 2535, held by applicant.

The proposed Reservoir will cover parts of S.W. 4 of NE 4, S.E. 4 of N.W. 4, E. 2 of S.W. 4 and S.E. 4 of Sec. 25, and N.E. 4 of Sec. 36, T. 43 N. R. 50 E., M.D.M.

5. Estimated cost of works: \$15,000.00

6. Estimated time required to construct works: 4 years.

7. Remarks: The North Fork of Deep Creek flows a large volume of water during the months of April, May, and part of June of normal years, but during rest of season is very low. It is planned to irrigate with the regular stream flow during the early part of the season and to store the surplus winter and spring water for the latter part.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This Permit to store the waters of the North Fork of Deep Creek to the extent of 2100 acre feet per annum is issued in conjunction with Permit No. 4933 and subject to all prior rights on the source. A proper headgate and regulating device must be installed in order to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 2100 acre feet per annum.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 1, 1931.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before November 1, 1931.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1935.

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before November 1, 1935.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 1, 1938

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before November 1, 1938.
