

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The undersigned W.T. Stewart, Jr. of Alamo, County of Lincoln, State of Nevada, hereby makes application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation give date and place of incorporation.)

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Crescent Valley reservoir and Tam Piute Tributary.
2. The amount of water applied for is One second-foot.
3. The water to be used for Stock Watering and Domestic
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: S 82° E 57080' dist from Baldy Peak on unsurveyed ground in T 5, S.R. 56 E.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 6, 1919.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 6, 1919.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before August 6, 1919.

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before September 6, 1919.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before May 6, 1920.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before June 6, 1920.
