The undersigned, Cooper & Uniacke, of Lovelock, Humboldt County, State of Nevada, hereby make application to change the point of Diversion and Place of Use of waters heretofore granted under Permit No. 3633.

The source of water supply of the proposed change, is Pleasant Valley Creek. The amount of water applied for to be changed is 1.00 second foot.

The water is to be used for irrigation and stock purposes.

The water for the proposed change of use and also for the balance of the lands described in Permit No. 3633, is to be diverted in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 12, T. 29 N., R. 38 E., M.D.M.

The point of diversion heretofore used under Permit No. 3633 is in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 11, T. 28 N., R. 38 E., M.D.M.

The water herewith desired to be changed, was described in Permit No. 3633 as follows; 8.79 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 23; 10.60 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$; 19.66 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$; 21.34 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$; 22.88 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$; 4.00 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$; 0.80 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$; 1.00 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$; 0.80 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$; all in Sec. 14; 0.85 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 11, all in T. 28 N., R. 38 E., M. D. M., but, it not being practical to irrigate said lands, desire to change same to lands described hereafter.

Number of acres heretofore irrigated is 357.09, being under Proof of Appropriation No. 01493 and Permit No. 3633.

Number of acres proposed to be irrigated is 457.09.

Description of land proposed to be irrigated is as follows; E $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 11, T. 28 N., R. 38 E. M.D.M.

Description of proposed works; A ditch taken out of Pleasant Valley Creek at the junction of same and Pole Creek, by means of dam and ditch, or concrete pipe and taken to land to be irrigated.

Estimated time to construct works, two years,

Estimated cost of proposed works, from Two hundred to 2000 dollars, depending upon whether it is necessary to concrete ditch or put in concrete pipe.

Irrigation will begin about March and end about September of each year.

Remarks; The purpose of the proposed change in the point of diversion is to conserve as much as possible, the waters of pleasant Valley Creek, which is lessening in volume for the last two years.

DIVERSION OF THE WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, AS GRANTED

The undersigned, Cooper & Uniacke, of Lovelock, County of Humboldt, State of Nevada, hereby make application to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of Pleasant Valley Creek heretofore granted under application and permit Number 3633, as hereinafter shown.

1. The source of the water supply proposed to be changed is Pleasant Valley Creek.
2. The quantity of water desired to be changed is 4.0 cubic feet per second.
3. The water is to be used for Irrigation and stock watering purposes.
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec.12, T.29 N.; R. 38 E., M.D.B. & M..
5. The existing point of diversion under the former appropriation is as follows: SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec.11; T.28 N., R. 38 E., M.D.B. & M..
6. The water herewith desired to be changed, was proposed to be beneficially, and continuously used upon the following described lands: SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$; Sec.11, E $\frac{1}{2}$ of Sec.14, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec.23, T.28 N., R.38 E., M.D.B. & M..
7. Number of acres proposed to be irrigated heretofore was 400 acres.
8. Number of acres proposed to be irrigated is 400 acres.
9. Description of land proposed to be irrigated is as follows: Portions of SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec.11, Portions of E $\frac{1}{2}$ of Sec.14, and Portion of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec.23, T.28 N., R. 38 E., M.D.B. & M..
10. Description of proposed works. A ditch taken out of Pleasant Valley Creek at the junction of same, and Pole Creek, by means of a dam, and ditch, or concrete pipe, and taken to land to be irrigated.
11. Estimate cost of proposed works is from Two Hundred Dollars to Two Thousand Dollars, depending upon whether it is necessary to concrete ditch, or put in concrete pipe.
12. Estimated time required to construct the works is Three years.
13. Irrigation will begin about March 1st and end about September 30th of each year.
14. The purpose of the proposed change in point of diversion is to conserve as much as possible, the waters of Pleasant Valley Creek, which is lessening in volume for the last two years. The purpose of the proposed change in place of use, is to abandon the water right from 8.79 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec.23, 10.60 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, 19.66 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, 21.34 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, 22.88 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$; 4.00 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$; 0.80 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$; 1.00 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$; 0.80 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$; Sec. 14, 0.85 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec.11, all in T.28 N., R. 38 E.; it not being practicable to irrigate said lands, and use the water upon the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$, and NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec.11, T.28 N., R.38 E., M.D.B. & M..

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the point of diversion and place of use of water heretofore granted under permit No. 3633, is issued with the understanding that no prior rights will be affected by the proposed change. Since the issuance of permit No. 3633, proof of appropriation No. 01493 has been filed, through which a vested right is claimed upon portions of the land to which the water right is to be transferred under this permit. It is accordingly understood that the 400 acres allowed a water right under this permit, changing the place of use of water originally granted under permit No. 3633, plus the acreage to which it is eventually determined a vested right attaches under proof of appropriation No. 01493 shall not exceed 520 acres, same being the total area of land within the tract to which the water right is changed hereunder.

The States reserves the right to regulate the use of water under this proposed change at any and all times. A substantial headgate and weir must be installed at or near the new point of diversion to facilitate the measurement and control of water.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 4.0 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 11, 1923. Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before December 11, 1923.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before November 11, 1925.

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before December 11, 1925.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before November 11, 1927.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State engineer on or before December 11, 1927.


