The undersigned Ambro Rosaschi
of Yerington, County of Lyon, State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation give date and place of incorporation.)

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Summit Spring
2. The amount of water applied for is .05 second-feet.
3. The water to be used for stock watering purposes
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: S 41°38' E, 2007 feet from 1/4 Sec. Cor. Sec. 18 (West boundary) T. 11 N., R. 28 E, M.D.B & M, probably in SE 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec 18, T. 11 N., R. 28 E, M.D.B & M.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. It is distinctly understood that applicant agrees to the terms herein contained.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.025 cubic feet per second. (One fortieth.)

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 24, 1920.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before May 24, 1920.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before January 24, 1921.

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before February 24, 1921.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before July 24, 1921. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before August 24, 1921.
