permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada,

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. It is distinctly understood that applicant agrees to the terms herein contained.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.2 cubic feet per second. ( One fifth )

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 11, 1920.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 11, 1920.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before November 11, 1920.

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before December 11, 1920.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before August 11, 1922. Proof of the application of water to beneficial

use must be filed with State Engineer on or before September 11, 1922.
