

TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The undersigned Frank A Thorley
of Panaca, County of Lincoln, State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Flood Waters of the water shed leading into upper Dry Lake
2. The amount of water applied for is 50 acre feet per annum
3. The water to be used for watering stock
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: SW 1/4 Sec 35 T.1 S.R.64 E.

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (g) Remarks This flood water will be stored in a reservoir during the storm season and there used to water about 300 head of Cattle and about 2000 head of Sheep during the dry weather

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Water is to be diverted by an earth dam in the main water course and conveyed to the reservoir thru a ditch 5000 feet in length, to the reservoir it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions. S.W. 1/4 S.W. 1/4 Sec. 1 T. 2 S. R. 64 E and there stored in a reservoir covering an area 300 feet by 1800 feet of the land of the S.W. 1/4 S.W. 1/4 Sec. 1 and the N.W. 1/4 N.W. 1/4 Sec. 12 T. 2 S. R. 64 E.

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. It is distinctly understood that applicant agrees to the terms herein contained.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 25 acre feet per annum.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 25, 1920.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before May 25, 1920.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 25, 1920.

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before November 25, 1920.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before April 25, 1921.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before May 25, 1921.
