The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.012 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 28, 1920

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before December 28, 1921

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before January 28, 1922

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before December 28, 1922
