of Reno, County of Washoe,
State of Nevada, hereby make application for

permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada,
as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation give date and
place of incorporation.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is North Fork of
Cotton Wood Creek
Name of stream, lake, or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 500 acre-feet
One second-foot equals 40 miners' inches.

3. The water to be used for Stockwatering purposes
Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.

4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following
point: in the SW 1/4 of SE 1/4 of section 34, T.35 N.R 22 E. M.D.B. & M.
Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, or by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Water is to be diverted by means of a dam and carried through a State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water ditch to reservoirs or reservoir. Also reservoirs may be constructed in convenient spots where the water may be stored for stock but particularly in a reservoir in the SE 1/4 of sec 34 and in the SW 1/4 of sec.35, T 35 N R 22 E. M.D.B.& M.
