of Battle Mt., County of Lander, State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation give date and place of incorporation.)

2. The amount of water applied for is Three 3 second-feet.
3. The water to be used for Mining and Domestic
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: in the N.W.1/4 northwest quarter of the Northwest Quarter N.W.1/4 of Section Twentynine (29) Township thirty one (31) North, Range 43 East. M.D.B. and M.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed Three cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 12, 1920.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 12, 1920.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before May 12, 1923.

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before June 12, 1923.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before May 12, 1924.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before June 12, 1924.
