

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all vested rights and prior rights for storage on Peavine Creek and tributaries. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 4,000 ~~subckoxfentxpxxsexoandx~~ acre feet of storage per annum.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 1, 1937

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before September 1, 1937

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before August 1, 1940

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before September 1, 1940

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before August 1, 1943 Proof of the application of water to beneficial

use must be filed with State Engineer on or before September 1, 1943.
