

TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The undersigned Griswold Henderson Live Stock Co.
of Elko, County of Elko, State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation give date and place of incorporation.) Incorporated, Nevada, 1904

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Hot Springs, known as and called, The Swimming Hole, located approximately 500 ft. due south of Hot Springs Bridge.
2. The amount of water applied for is fifteen second-feet.
3. The water to be used for irrigation, domestic and stock watering purposes.
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: SE Quarter of the NE Quarter Sec. 21, T 34 N R 55 E MBD&M

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (a) Number of acres to be irrigated is Fifteen hundred
(b) Description of land to be irrigated SW Quarter, South half of the NW Quarter of Sec. 21, SE Quarter & South half of the SW quarter Sec. 20, All of Section 29, the East half of the east half of Sec. 30, the south west quarter of the NE quarter Sec. 30; All in T 34 N R 55 E MBD&M

- (c) Irrigation will begin about March 1st and end about Nov. 30th of each year.

IF WATER IS TO BE USED FOR POWER, MINING, TRANSPORTATION, OR OTHER USE, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (d) Power to be developed is horsepower.

REMARKS:

Lands described above heretofore irrigated partially by waters of the Humboldt River by means of dams, ditches and laterals, conveying water to and upon said lands, as shown by that certain cultural map on file in the State Engineer's office, whereby said lands are described and said map made by B.G. McBride and acknowledged by Edwin E. Caine, on the 25th day of May, 1912, and as shown in the Abstract of Claims on Page 84. Prior vested right in and to said waters over-flowing from said spring under prior uses. Owing to cost of irrigation and the necessity of additional waters this application filed for all waters developed from said spring by above means. Said waters heretofore claimed as waters of the Humboldt River. Within knowledge and information of applicant there are no prior claimants for said waters and no vested rights in and to said waters, excepting as above specified. Within knowledge and information of applicant no other party or parties whomsoever in position to make beneficial use of the waters from said spring. In addition to the land above described this application is made for the use of waters on all land owned by the Griswold-Henderson Live Stock Co, on that certain ranch known as and called Moody Ranch, approximately one mile west of Elko and said ranch contains approximately 1375 acres.
