permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada,

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Deep Creek in

2. The amount of water applied for is 640 acre second-foot.

4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following
point: From Deep Creek in California in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 28, T. 7 N.

(g) Remarks The water covered by this application was appropriated in
the State of California in October, 1911, by complying with the laws of
California relative to the appropriation of water. The water is to be
conveyed by ditch to the channel of Desert Creek and thence taken
thru the said channel to the point of re-diversion above described.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

The water will be diverted from Desert Creek at approximately the point of diversion heretofore described, which point is the same as that described in permit 4248 held by the Hunewill Land and Livestock Co. Said diversion will be made by dam and ditch and conveyed about one and one half miles to Dry Lake, approximately in Sec. 10, T. 8 N. R. 24 E., where a reservoir is to be constructed by means of an earthen dam about 300 feet long and fifty feet high. This application is made to serve the purpose of changing the point of diversion of the waters of Desert Creek as granted applicant under permit No. 4451.

5. Estimated cost of works \$15000 for entire project.
6. Estimated time required to construct works five years.
7. Remarks it is more feasible for him to consolidate his project with the one proposed by the Hunewill Land and Livestock Co. under permit No. 4248, using the same main ditch and same reservoir, and thus with the consent of the said Company is making this application to divert the water at the same point proposed by them. This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 640 acre cubic feet per second, annum

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 14th, 1921

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before August 14th, 1921

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 14th, 1925

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before August 14th, 1925

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before

October 14th, 1926 Proof of the application of water to beneficial

use must be filed with State Engineer on or before November 14th, 1926

Since this permit constitutes, in reality, an appropriation from Deep Creek in California, the same is issued with the understanding that steps have been taken to acquire a right in California in accordance with the laws of that State. No appropriation having been contemplated from Desert Creek, and no right to any of the waters thereof being granted, it is understood and agreed that a standard headgate and weir will be installed, both at the point where the ditch from Deep Creek forms confluence with Desert Creek, and at the point of diversion from Desert Creek, in order that there will be no interference with the flow of said Desert Creek.

The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. It is distinctly understood that applicant agrees to the terms herein contained.
