3. The water to be used for Irrigation & stock



(b) Description of land to be irrigated All or parts of legal subdivisions following, to wit: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 and NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 21; SW 1/4 NW 1/4, N 1/2 SW 1/4, SE 1/4 SW 1/4, S 1/2 NE 1/4, and SE 1/4, of Sec. 22; and NE 1/4 NW 1/4 and NW 1/4 NE 1/4, of Sec. 27; all in Tp. 20 N., R. 29 E., Mt. D.M.
(c) Irrigation will begin about April 1 and end about Oct. 15 of each year.
