 permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada,

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Petersons Springs.

Situated in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 29 and NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 32, in Township 15
N. Range 39 East M. D. B. & M.
2. The amount of water applied for is One and 40/100 second-feet.
One second-foot equals 40 miners' inches.
3. The water to be used for Irrigation, and Domestic purposes.
Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following
 point: within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 29 Township 15 N. Range 39 E.M.
Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, or by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

By a Dam constructed across the water chanel and converted into State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water ditch, or ditches to convey it to parcels, or tracts of land is to be stored in reservoirs it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions herein described.


