The undersigned LYNN BIG SIX MINING COMPANY, a corporation organized under and existing by virtue of the laws of the State of Nevada, Edwin E. Caine of Elko, County of Elko

State of Nevada, its attorney, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation give date and place of incorporation.) Carson City, Nevada, November 19, 1913

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is unnamed spring site in NW 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec. 2, Tp. 35 N. R. 50 E. M. D. M. Eureka county, Nevada. Name of stream, lake, or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is one second-foot. One second-foot equals 40 miners' inches.

3. The water to be used for mining, milling and domestic purposes. Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.

4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: NW 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Section 2, Tp. 35 N. R. 50 E. M. D. M. Plat for this Township not yet filed altho survey has been made. Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, or by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

It is the intention of applicant to develop the spring by excavation in state manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water is to be stored in reservoirs it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions. pipe it in as direct a line as possible from the Spring to the Big Six No. 3 Mining Claim, where the water is to be used for mining, milling and domestic purposes.
