hereby make application for
permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada,
as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation give date and
place of incorporation.) March 4, 1912. Reno, Nevada.

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Tiger Canon and in
NW 1/4 of SE 1/4, Sec. 20, T. 21 N. R. 23 E, Washoe County, Nevada, from springs
and flowing water.
2. The amount of water applied for is 3 second-feet.
3. The water to be used for Power, mining, domestic & milling purposes.
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following
point: in Tiger Canon in the Northwest quarter (NW 1/4) of the South-
east quarter (SE 1/4), Section Twenty (20) Township Twenty-one (21)
North, Range Twenty-three (23) east.

Water is to be diverted by dam into tanks or ditches and pipes, and conveyed by ditches, flumes and pipe in an easterly direction through said section and through the adjoining section 21, into the SW 1/4 of SE 1/4 Section 21 East, Township 21 North, Range 23 E. where power plant is to be located for power purposes.

The estimated time required to complete the application of the water to beneficial use, - four years.

The vertical head under which the water will be applied is 100 feet. The location of the proposed power house will be in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 21, Township 21, North, Range 23 East, Washoe County, Nevada, and the use of the power will be for mining, milling and lighting and for domestic purposes for employees at the company's mine, and the approximate number of such persons are ten (10) and the approximate future requirements will be five hundred (500). The method proposed to use the power for mining is in the production of power for drilling, lighting, mining, hoisting and for mill purposes.

It is proposed to develop the springs and subsurface flow in Tiger Canon, and complete a concrete reservoir or dam immediately below the several springs and convey the water by pipe from said dam or reservoir and said dam or dams or reservoir will be of sufficient dimensions to hold the water now existing and that may be developed.

It is also proposed to deliver the water into a stand pipe or reservoir in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 21, Township 21, North, Range 23 East, and to convey the water therefrom by pipe about 300 feet in a southeasterly direction to a power house for the purpose of developing power and to convey said water by pipes from said stand pipe or reservoir for domestic purposes.
