of Golconda, County of Humboldt, State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation give date and place of incorporation.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is "Moores" Springs. Name of stream, lake, or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is Two (2) second-feet. One second-foot equals 40 miners' inches.

3. The water to be used for Mining and domestic use. Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.

4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: S.W. 1/4 of N.W. 1/4 Sec. 31. Tp 34 N-R 40 E. M.D.B.M. or by approximate survey tie, as being S 15-50'E 1525. ft from the N.W. Cor, Sec, 31. Tp 34 N-R 40.E., Bearing and distance scaled off of survey..

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

(a) Number of acres to be irrigated is None.

(b) Description of land to be irrigated None. Describe by legal subdivision, or if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated and a description provided in accordance with special instruction from the State Engineer when application is returned for correction.

(c) Irrigation will begin about None. and end about Month. of each year.

IF WATER IS TO BE USED FOR POWER, MINING, TRANSPORTATION, OR OTHER USE, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

(d) Power to be developed is horsepower.

(e) Works to be located S.E. 1/4 of S.W. 1/4 Sec, 30 Tp 34 N-R 40 E. M.D.B.M. Give 40-acre subdivision on which works will be located, or locate by course and distance to a section corner.

(f) Point of return of water to stream None. Describe in same manner as point of diversion.

(g) Remarks The Spring is a small one, but it is the purpose of the applicant to do much work and develop more water, also to pipe it to the mines and mining camp where it is to be used.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source. It is understood that the 2.0 c.f. s. herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to a beneficial use. Provision must be made for the installation of a measuring device and accurate measurements of the water placed to beneficial use must be included in the proof of beneficial use when filed. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. It is distinctly understood that applicant agrees to the terms herein contained.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 2.0 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 17, 1922.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before November 17, 1922.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 17, 1925.

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before November 17, 1925.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 17, 1927. Proof of the application of water to beneficial

use must be filed with State Engineer on or before November 17, 1927.
