

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The undersigned P. Lambert & Company,
of Cherry Creek, County of White Pine,
State of Nevada, hereby makes application for
permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada,
as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation give date and
place of incorporation.) August 1, 1918, Cherry Creek, Nevada.

2. The amount of water applied for is 1/2 miners inch second-feet.

whence the NE. Cor. Sec. 11, T. 25 N., R. 60 E., M.D.B. and M., bears
N. 47° 40' E., 6015 feet.

is to be stored in reservoirs it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before  
August 8, 1922 Proof of the application of water to beneficial

use must be filed with State Engineer on or before September 8, 1922
