The undersigned Francis A. Swayne,
of Denio, County of Harney,
State of Oregon, hereby makes application for
permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada,
as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation give date and
place of incorporation.)

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Swayne Springs,
2. The amount of water applied for is One second-feet.
3. The water to be used for Domestic and irrigation purposes
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following
point: in lot No. 1, of the North East quarter of Section 2 (Two)
Township Forty two North Range twenty-five East M.D.M.

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (a) Number of acres to be irrigated is One Hundred
(b) Description of land to be irrigated Lot No. one (1) and the
South half of the North east quarter of Section 2, Township 42 North
Range 25 east M.D.M., Humboldt County Nevada.
(c) Irrigation will begin about April 15th and end about
Dec. 1st, of each year.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Water is flowing in narrow channel seldom carrying more than 25 miners State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water inches, and will be diverted through a weir and headgates and local is to be stored in reservoirs it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions. dirt dams as needed as this application carries entire stream, and it is intended within not over two years to conduct same by pipe line from the springs where it originates to where it is to be used for domestic water, and beginning irrigation work. This water has been used under permit 3542 on this land for the past three years, and ditches are already in use to apply the water to beneficial use on the land.

5. Estimated cost of works \$250.00 if pipe line is laid as projected.

6. Estimated time required to construct works One year.

7. Remarks/irrigated, and none of it passes across the land when not restrained, and has been put to beneficial use by applicant, and all necessary ditches constructed, and as the springs rise on the mountain side immediately above the land can be of benefit only to the land for which this application is made. This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source. A standard headgate and weir must be installed at or near the point of diversion to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. It is distinctly understood that the applicant agrees to the terms herein contained.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.0 cubic feet per second. (One)

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 4, 1920

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before July 4, 1920

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 4, 1921

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before July 4, 1921

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before June 4, 1922

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before July 4, 1922
