The undersigned Carson River Mills Company
of Dayton, County of Lyon, State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation give date and place of incorporation.) August 15, 1919, State of Utah

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is flood & unappropriated waters of Carson River at the Company's mill about 5 miles below Dayton, Nevada
2. The amount of water applied for is .4 second-feet.
