The undersigned, ANTELOPE VALLEY LAND AND CATTLE COMPANY of Reno, Washoe County, Nevada, a corporation formed under the laws of the State of California in the year 1912, hereby makes application to change the point of diversion of waters heretofore appropriated, and beneficially used, as hereinafter shown.

1. The source of the water supply of the proposed change is Walker River, Lyon County, Nevada.
2. The amount of water applied for to be changed is 156.63 cubic feet per second.
3. The water is to be used for irrigation, stock-watering, and domestic purposes.
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: The Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section Two (2), Township Thirteen (13) North, Range Twenty-five (25) East, M.D.B. & M.
5. The points of diversion heretofore used for diverting water from the Walker River under the appropriations sought to be changed are as follows:

Merritt Ditch, - The Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section Three (3), Township Thirteen (13) North, Range Twenty-five (25) East, M.D.B. & M.;

Joggles Ditch, - The Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section Thirty-six (36), Township Fourteen North, Range Twenty-five (25) East, M.D.B. & M., and also at some point on Merritt Ditch at times.

Lane & Johnson Ditch, - in the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section Thirty-six (36), Township Fourteen (14) North, Range Twenty-five (25) East, M.D.B. & M.; and

Gold Hill Ditch, - in the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section Thirty-five (35), or immediately across the section line in Section Thirty-six (36), of Township Fourteen (14) North, Range Twenty-five (25) East, M.D.B. & M.

(The water has been diverted heretofore through the Joggles Ditch, the Merritt Ditch, the Lane & Johnson Ditch, and the Gold Hill Ditch.)

6. The water herewith applied for to be changed has been beneficially and continuously used upon the following described lands:

Through the Joggles Ditch and Merritt Ditch, on east side of the Walker River, naming the irrigated sections, in whole or in part, as follows: Section 1 and 2, Township 13 North, Range 25 East; parts of Sections 1, 12, 13, 24, 25, and 36 of Township 14 North, Range 25 East; parts or all of Sections 19, 20, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, and 34 of Township 15 North, Range 26 East; parts or all of Sections 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 29, 30, and 31, of Township 14 North, Range 26 East; all in M.D.B. & M.; and

On West side, through the Gold Hill Ditch, the Lane & Johnson Ditch, and other minor ditches, together with the Spragg, Buley and Alcorn Ditch (change for which is already granted), parts or all of the sections following: The East Half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 2, and part of the Northeast Quarter of Section 2, Township 13 North, Range 25 East; parts or all of Sections 35, 36, 25, 26, 23, 24, 13, 14, 11, 12; and 1, of Township 14 North, Range 25 East. Parts of Sections 19, 20, 30, and 31 of Township 15 North, Range 26 East, and Parts of Sections 24, 25, and 36 of Township 15 North, Range 25 East; all in M.D.B. & M.;

Being the land named in the proofs filed with the State Engineer and awarded water rights in the final decree in the United States District Court for the District of Nevada, in the case of Pacific Livestock Company, a corporation, Complainant, vs. Thomas B. Rickey, et al, Defendants, and the lands named in Application and Permit No. 2308, issued by the State Engineer of Nevada, to which instruments reference is hereby made, and which are made a part hereof, for the purpose of designating more specifically the lands for which water has been appropriated and for which the point of diversion is desired to be changed.

Reference is also made to Application No. 5429, approved by the State Engineer, permitting a change in point of diversion of certain waters heretofore diverted through the Spragg, Alcorn, & Buley Ditch.

7. The number of acres heretofore irrigated is about 15000.

8. The number of acres proposed to be irrigated is about 15000.

9. The description of the land proposed to be irrigated is as designated in Paragraph 6 above.

10. The estimated cost of the proposed works is five thousand (\$5,000.00) dollars.

11. The estimated time required to construct the works is two (2) years after approval.

12. Irrigation will begin about March first of each year, and end about November first of each year, but without specifically limiting the season, the water will be used, as heretofore, whenever conditions permit, at any time throughout the year.

13. The water has been used heretofore during the months beginning March first and ending November first, each year, and sometimes at earlier and later periods, when water conditions permitted.

14. REMARKS: It is intended by this application to change the point of diversion of the waters heretofore appropriated and used, or appropriated and in the process of use and perfection, of appropriation, through the above-named ditches on the property of the applicant, the purpose being to consolidate the various ditches and make one modern concrete sluice-way dam, and eliminate the up-keep of several dams now existing, and which are obsolete.

The priority of the right, as well as the extent thereof, is fixed by the aforesaid decree rendered in the case of Pacific Livestock Company, Complainant, vs. Thomas B. Rickey, et al., Defendants, and also by Permit No. 2308 issued by the State Engineer.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the points of diversion of the Merritt, Joggles, Lane & Johnson, and Gold Hill Ditches, is issued with the understanding that no other rights will be impaired thereby, and with the further understanding that no additional rights are granted herein.

A substantial headgate and weir must be installed at the new point of diversion to facilitate the measurement and control of water.

The State reserves the right to regulate the use of water under the change authorized by this permit, at any time, in accordance with the stipulation, or any modification thereof, in that certain U. S. District Court Decree No. 731, in the case entitled Pacific Livestock Co., vs. T. B. Rickey, et al., and in accordance with the terms of Permit No. 2308.

The amount of water which may be diverted at the new point of diversion shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed the amount at present used by the applicant through the ditches above named, namely 119.88 cubic feet of water per second, ^{for 10000 acres} as set forth in that certain U. S. District Court Decree No. 731, in the case entitled Pacific Livestock Co., vs. T. B. Rickey et al., and 36.75 cubic feet per second, ^{for 3675 acres} as granted under permit No. 2308, making a total of 156.63 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 15, 1923.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 15, 1923.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before May 15, 1924.

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before June 15, 1924.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before November 15, 1924. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before December 15, 1924.
