permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada,

Subterranean waters,
2. The amount of water applied for is Two (2) second-feet.
3. The water to be used for irrigation and domestic purposes,
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following
point: NE 1/4 of SW 1/4, Sec. 28, T. 14 N., R. 20 E., M. D. B. & M.,

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (a) Number of acres to be irrigated is 164 Acres,
(b) Description of land to be irrigated SW 1/4, Sec. 28, T. 14 N.,
R. 20 E., M. D. B. & M.,

- (c) Irrigation will begin about January 1st and end about
December 31st, of each year.

IF WATER IS TO BE USED FOR POWER, MINING, TRANSPORTATION, OR OTHER USE, SUPPLY THE

- (d) Power to be developed is horsepower.
(e) Works to be located

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: rights on the source. It is assumed, by the granting of this application, that the waters herein applied for are not percolating and therefore come within the jurisdiction of the Office of State Engineer.

A substantial weir must be installed and maintained at or near the source to facilitate the measurement and control of water.

The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the waters herein granted at any and all times.

It is distinctly understood that the applicant agrees to the terms herein contained.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.64 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 9, 1921

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before May 9, 1921

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before April 9, 1923

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before May 9, 1923

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before June 9, 1925. Proof of the application of water to beneficial

use must be filed with State Engineer on or before July 9, 1925
