The undersigned, Samuel Baker, of Gold Creek, County of Elko, State of Nevada, hereby makes application to change the place of use of waters heretofore appropriated under application and permit No. 2985, as hereinafter shown.

1. The source of the water supply proposed to be changed is Sam's Creek, a tributary of Hay Meadow Creek.
2. The quantity of water desired to be changed is 1.6 cubic feet per second.
3. The water is to be used for irrigation and domestic purposes.
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 33, T. 44 N., R. 56 E., M. D. B. & M.,
5. The existing point of diversion under the former appropriation is the same as under question No. 4.
6. The water, herewith desired to be changed, was proposed to be beneficially and continuously used upon the following described lands: N $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Lots 1, 2, 3 and 8, of Sec. 32, T. 44 N., R. 56 E., M. D. B. & M..
7. Number of acres proposed to be irrigated heretofore was 160 acres.
8. Number of acres proposed to be irrigated is 160 acres.
9. Description of the land proposed to be irrigated is as follows: NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Lots 1, 2, 3, and 8, Sec. 32, and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 33, T. 44 N., R. 56 E., M. D. B. & M..
10. Description of proposed works is a dam to be placed in Sam's Creek at the point above indicated, and an excavated ditch leading therefrom to and over the lands proposed to be irrigated.
11. Estimated cost of proposed works is Two Hundred Dollars.
12. Estimated time required to construct the works is one month.
13. Irrigation will begin about April 1st of each year and end about August 1st of each year.
14. Remarks: The place of use of the water herein desired to be changed is from the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 32, T. 44 N., R. 56 E., to the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 33, T. 44 N., R. 56 E., M. D. B. & M.. Applicant in submitting his application No. 2985 intended to include the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 33, T. 44 N., R. 56 E., instead of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 32, T. 44 N., R. 56 E., but on account of a survey made at or about said time, a mistake was made in the original application No. 2985. Applicant has beneficially used some of the waters applied for under application No. 2985 upon the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, of said Sec. 33, under the supposition hereinabove set forth, and has not used any of said waters beneficially upon the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 32 of said township and range.
