This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source. Water is allowed hereunder for 160 acres in the NW 1/4 of Sec. 14, T. 41N.R. 28 E., and for 160 acres for which no water right attaches under prior filings within the various lots proposed to be irrigated in Sec. 21, T. 41N.R. 28 E. It is made a requirement of this permit that a cultural map shall be furnished with the proof of beneficial use specifically segregating the land which has been irrigated under each of the prior filings and the land irrigated under this permit. A substantial headgate and weir must be installed at or near the point of diversion to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of water herein granted at any and all times. It is distinctly understood that the applicant agrees to the terms herein contained.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before August 30, 1923
