Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 1, 1921

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1923

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before July 1, 1923

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before November 1, 1923. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before December 1, 1923
