permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada,

Canyon, East Side of Spring Valley-15 Miles N of Osceola, White Pine Co
2. The amount of water applied for is One & one half / second-feet.
3. The water to be used for Power, Mining & Concentrating
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following
point: Nine hundred (900) feet below source of Springs. This is on
unsurveyed land and the S.E. Cor T.19, N.R.67, E.M.D.M. Bears N75°W
27600 feet.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source, and is for mining and concentrating purposes only. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. It is distinctly understood that applicant agrees to the terms herein contained.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1-1/2 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 1, 1921

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before July 1, 1921

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before November 1, 1921

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before December 1, 1921

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 1, 1924

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before November 1, 1924
